

The Township meeting held on January 3, 2017 at 7:00 PM was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Officers

All members were present; Sec-Treasurer Beverly Henderson, Solicitor Matthew Gieg, Twp. Engineer Thomas Levine were present.

Minutes

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to accept the meeting minutes of December 6, 2016 and December 16, 2016 as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Announcements an Executive Session was held at 6:45 PM for Legal Matters.

General Comments Mr. Robert Clapper, Regis Nale, and Joy Eger was present on behalf of the Blair County Heritage Association. Mr. Nale was the spoke person, Mr. Nale had presented a packet to the Board of Supervisor, and with several letters from different organization concerning the Growmiller Bridge (Swinging Bridge) located within the Lower Reese area. With the support of Frankstown Township, though a Proclamation stating that the Frankstown Township Board of Supervisors recognizes the bridge is located within the Township, the Blair County Heritage Association could apply to the Pa at Risk Program for grants to help restore the bridge. P. Joseph Lehman & Associates just looking at the bridge quoted a price in the neighborhood of \$50,000.00 to \$60,000.00. Solicitor Gieg stated that prior to the Township agreeing to a proclamation he would have to check into it further.

Stormwater Issue: The Township is part of the Inter municipal Stormwater Committee, one of the requirements is that the Township needs to appoint a Representative and an Alternate to the committee. A motion was made by Kenneth Wertz and 2nd by George Henry to appoint Thomas Levine as the Representative and Lewis Reese as the Alternate to the Inter-municipal Stormwater Committee. The motion passed unanimously.
