Roll Call of Officers

Minutes

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to accept the meeting minutes of April 4, 2017 as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to accept the Treasurer report as presented for the month of April. The motion passed unanimously.

General Comments

William Calvert 1412 Locke Mt. Rd is requesting a lighting and noise ordinance, Mr. Calvert stated that he should have requested that a banquet hall not be allowed within 1000 ft. of a residence. Mr. Calvert stated there was a party this past Saturday and text Dr. Aswappatha at 10:45 PM and threaten to call the police.

Mr. and Mrs. Timothy Pupo, as well as Mr. Timothy Heist was present concerning 2 residence within the Old Town Village. 135 Fiore Lane the grass is 8 to 12 inches high, trees were never cut. The residence are requesting that this residence be cleaned up. As well as the residence at 120 Fiore Lane stating that the house is vacant however the grass is being cut but the shrub needs to be cut.

Stormwater Issue: Mr. Lynn Granville was present with pictures that showed the water in front of Mrs. Paul, stating that the driveway pipe may need to be replaced and the swale from the Mr. Pialentini swimming pool project will have to replace as well, at his cost.

Old Business

Steve Dillen Stormwater Management Plan approx... 6 months ago Mr. Dillen had a subdivision located off Beaver Dam Rd and since he is located within the Canoe Lake which is a except high quality water shed he had to apply for an Individual NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharge from DEP. The approval was received and according to our ordinance Mr. Dillen still has to enter into a maintenance agreement with the Township and also provide Financial Surety. A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to accept the Stormwater

Management plan approved by DEP subject to the maintenance agreement and the financial surety. The motion passed unanimously.

Allegheny Lutheran Social Ministry reduction in Financial Surety. A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to reduce ALSM financial surety by \$909,643.10 leaving a balance of \$345,761.90. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Frank & Yvonne Luciano Side Lot Addition due to the lack of ownership signature a motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to table this subdivision until the following meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

Resolution to charge for sewer inspection on accessory building a motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by George Henry to accept Resolution 20170502 giving the Township the ability to charge \$75.00 for the inspection fees for any accessory building being connected to public sewer. The motion passed unanimously.

Wilson Cul-de-sac a sales agreement is drafted and the closing on the property will be done next week.
