

The Township meeting held on May 3, 2016 at 7:00 PM was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Officers

All members were present; Sec-Treasurer Beverly Henderson, Solicitor Matthew Gieg, Twp. Engineer Thomas Levine were present.

Minutes

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to accept the meeting minutes of April 5, 2016 and April 11, 2016, as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by George Henry to accept the Treasurer report as presented for April. The motion passed unanimously.

General Comments: Ms. Elizabeth Higgi was present on behalf of Dr. Aswathappa subdivision located off Locke Mt. Road. Ms. Higgi updated the Board on the process of the subdivision, with the following: most of the approvals that are needed will come from outside sources, such as the DEP, Penn Dot, and MDIA. The Blair County Planning Commission had given them conditional approval. Ms. Higgi also stated that the Dr. Aswathappa is under a line and if the Board would consider a special meeting. The Board had agree to the special meeting if it would be in the middle of the month but if it is a couple days prior to the regular meeting, they would rather have the regular meeting. Ms. Higgi also question about the legal aspect, Solicitor Gieg question how soon will the submission to MDIA take, Dr. Aswathappa stated by Friday or Monday.

Old Business:

Dr. Aswathappa Component 2 Submission to DEP a motion was made by Kenneth Wertz and 2nd by James Grove to approve the submission of the Component 2 to DEP and authorizing the Secretary/Treasurer to sign all the documents on behalf of Frankstown Township. The motion passed unanimously.

Penn Dot now requires a Traffic Impact Study paperwork to be filled out for this Subdivision, Dr. Aswathappa needs a change of use HOP for his driveway. A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by George Henry authorizing Engineer Levine to sign the TIS for the Penn Dot HOP. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business:

Ratify the Stormwater Manage Plan Approval. The following stormwater plans were approved within the month of April.

A motion was made by Kenneth Wertz and 2nd by George Henry to approve the Greg Gorman stormwater plan located off Scotch Valley Rd. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to approve the Steve Oppel stormwater plan located off Scotch Valley Rd. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to approve the Paul Shields stormwater plan located off Shaw Rd. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by George Henry to approve the Cory DelBiondo located West Loop Rd. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Kenneth Wertz and 2nd by George Henry to approve the Rana Storm located within Country Side Estates. The motion passed unanimously.

Resolution of Support for the 9-11 National Memorial Trail a motion was by Kenneth Wertz and 2nd by George Henry to adopt the Resolution of Support for the 9-11 National Memorial Trail. Supervisors Henry and Wertz were in favor, Supervisor Grove opposed.

Stormwater Ordinance Amendment a motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by George Henry authorizing Solicitor Gieg the advertising of the Stormwater Ordinance Amendment, going for 1,000 square feet to 1 acre. The motion passed unanimously.

CDBG Program a motion was by James Grove and 2nd by George Henry adopting the Resolution for Program Income Reuse Program for the CDBG Program. The motion passed unanimously.

Paul Randy Spigelmyer Subdivision Engineer Levine presented the subdivision for reasons to forward the planning module on to DEP, a 3 lot minor subdivision located off Beaver Dam Rd. a motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to authorize the submission of the planning module on to DEP. The motion passed unanimously.

Disaster Relief A meeting is scheduled for Wednesday May 4, 2016 for the Disaster Relief for winter storm Jonas, A motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz appointing Paul Singer Road Foreman as the Agent to sign on behalf of Frankstown Township with regards to this winter storm. The motion passed unanimously.

Other Comments Mr. William Calvert was present concerning a request for a noise ordinance with regards to the prospective party barn being located across the street from where Mr. Calvert lives, as well as the 4 wheeler running around. Mr. Calvert has also requested a lighting ordinance, stating the lights off the barn shine in his house and bedroom. Dr. Aswathappa stated that they are the same lights that was on the pole they just removed the pole and placed them on the barn. Their conversation went back and forwards for a period of time.

Supervisor Henry had ask Dr. Aswathappa to place shield around the lights.

Mr. Terry Schaffer Sylvan Dr. was present to commend the Secretary for pointing Mr. Schaffer in the right direction in Penn Dot and that they were to meet with him at a later date,

however he was asking the Board if anything can be done with the speeding, and if the stop sign can become a true stop sign.

The regular Township meeting adjourned at 7:47 PM, a motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz The motion passed unanimously.
