Stormwater Issue

Mr. Scott Brenneman reached out to Engineer Levine stating that he is ready for the Township to process with the ditch work at his residence and will grant an easement for the same.

Old Business:

Mutual Aid Agreement has circle back around with a very basic version. Attorney Oswald has contacted Solicitor Gieg to see if we are planning on moving forward with the agreement. It is the understanding of Solicitor Gieg that PEMA has been notified and in the event that there is a State Disaster and we are not part of this agreement then we won't get any funds for said event. At this meeting Supervisor Henry tabled there decision and will have an answer within 30 days.

New Business:

2018 Activities List for the Fire Company has been summited to the Secretary, Solicitor Gieg felt the need for a resolution with that, a motion was made by James Grove and 2nd by Kenneth Wertz to accept the 2018 Activities List from the Fire Company via a Resolution. The motion passed unanimously.

Bill Van Atta was present on behalf of the Fire Company to give his monthly report, which included:

- 76 calls with assist to Williamsburg structure fire and 2 calls on Monday.
- Cambria County Fire School, with multiply class offered.
- 7 week of fish dinner sold totaled 3700 dinner

There was a brief discussion concerning the kitchen drawings, and who has the copy and if Pam Smith, Cindy Pooler and Robin Grove, the ladies of the kitchen, had seen the drawings. Chairman Henry made a suggestion to Engineer Levine what if our man did the excavating work, to save some money.

Harry Acker was present questioning why the dumpster were removed, Supervisor Wertz stated that he had found several things in the co-mingle that is not recyclable, such as sink, toilets, styrofoam, carpet, house hold trash, and boats the clothes bin was right there but instead of putting them in the clothes bin they put them in the co-mingle dumpster. Ken Wertz was taking the dumpster into Altoona at his cost, in total over 5 year period the Township had paid \$21,692.99 for the recycling.

Lenny Metz stated he feels it was a way for some people not to have a trash man.
