

The regular Township meeting was held on July 6, 2021, at 7:00 PM. It was called to order and opened with the pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Officers

Supervisors, George Henry, James Callahan and Kenneth Wertz were present. Sec-Treasurer Beverly Henderson, Engineer Thomas Levine, Solicitor Matthew Gieg and Assistant Secretary Robbin Grove were present.

Minutes

A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to accept the meeting minutes of June 1, 2021, as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business:

Sewer Authority: A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to advertise the extension of the Sewer Authority. The motion passed unanimously.

Amended Developers Agreement Allegheny Lutheran Social Ministry: Engineer Levine and Solicitor Gieg have worked together on this. There were some legal technicalities that had to be changed because it was purchased after it was developed. To make it clearer, Solicitor Gieg prepared a new agreement. A motion was made by James Callahan second by Kenneth Wertz to adopt the Amended Developers Agreement for ALSM. The motion passed unanimously.

Supervisor Callahan said that he had seen in the new PSATS book that you could start to advertise on the internet instead of in the paper. Engineer Levine asked if it said anything about how to spend the COVID money in the book. Sect-Treasurer Henderson said she is in the process of working on how to get a COVID credit on our 941.

Supervisor Wertz said Grannas Bros. was doing the line painting on Godfrey Lane tomorrow, July 7, 2021. He also stated that we need two weed eaters. He would like to purchase the STIHL brand. We also need tires for the backhoe from Goods Tires. Supervisor Callahan wants a quote from Valley Tire just for the paper work then foreman Miller has to fill out a request form.

Supervisor Henry asked about the paper work from PenDot and Secretary Henderson said it was taken care of. Solicitor Gieg Said that two of the five easements were signed for the Frankstown Road sewer extension. Two of the people might be an issue.

Supervisor Callahan had asked if we were getting any complaints about the bridge and about the eight box culverts we have at the park. Supervisor Callahan said about selling them and there was a discussion about using them other places in the Township for projects.

New Enterprise might be able to do the cut in the road for us. Engineer Levin called Dewey and talked to his wife. He gave her his contact information a week ago but has not received a call back.

Mr. Lynn Granville questioned about when the speed bumps on Brush Mt. Rd. were going to be put in. Supervisor Henry said we were getting some prices. Mr. Granville thought we were doing that in-house and we are not. We also need the signs and they are 2 weeks out yet. Secretary Henderson said she is waiting for them to start complaining about Scotch Valley and there was a discussion about it. Supervisor Callahan asked if there were many complaints about the speeding and Secretary Henderson said there were. Supervisor Henry said we could use liquid fuels money for it so we will see how things go on Brush Mt. Rd. project.

With no other business before the Board of Supervisors, the meeting adjourned at 7:17 PM with a motion made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz. The motion passed unanimously.
