

The regular Township meeting was held on June 7, 2022, at 7:00 PM. It was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Officers

Supervisors, George Henry, James Callahan and Kenneth Wertz were present. Sec-Treasurer Beverly Henderson, Solicitor Matthew Gieg, Engineer Thomas Levine and Assistant Sec. Robbin Grove were present.

Minutes

General Comments:

Old Business:

- Gary Gates was present requesting an update on the proposed stormwater ditch to be installed by his home. Engineer Levine was asked to give an update. Engineer Levine stated Mr. Gates is on the list, however he would have to check with Mr. Miller to see where he is with the material purchase. Supervisor Henry stated with the cost of material and the fact that we are currently down five guys - it may take a while for the road crew to get up there. Mr. Gates stated that on the June 1, 2021, it was stated in the minutes that once the new garage was completed this project would be next. Engineer Levine is to do a follow up call.
- Roxanne Copp was present concerning the flooding within Ajay Development. Ms. Copp stated that the ditch within this development needs some dressing up and that the ditches on Elm Street are beautiful. Ms. Copp also stated that a lot of their flood waters are coming from Elm Street and Maple Street. She also stated that her daughter got three inches of water in her garage. Ms. Copp stated that she has a vacant lot near her house that would be a perfect spot for a retention pond. The Board wondered if she would donate the ground for the retention pond she laughed and said she would sell it at a good price.
- Supervisor Henry told Lynn Granville that the Borough of Hollidaysburg will be working on Godfrey Lane and Brush Mountain Rd.

New Business: there was no new business.

The board retired into a short executive session for legal matters.
