

The regular Township meeting was held on October 4, 2022, at 7:00 PM. It was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Officers

Supervisors, George Henry, James Callahan were present. Sec-Treasurer Beverly Henderson, Solicitor Matthew Gieg, Engineer Levine and Assistant Sec. Robbin Grove were present. Kenneth Wertz was absent.

Minutes

Solicitor Gieg stated that the Dr. & Mrs. Singer easement for the SHNIF LLC subdivision has been received and that the easement, developer's agreement and subdivision will be recorded tomorrow October 5, 2022.

Trina Illig stated that the Fire Dept. has made contact with her and stated that they are seeking \$25,100.00 for fund raisers that they couldn't hold due to the COVID. Ms. Illig stated that DCED is reviewing the paper work. Ms. Illig also stated that there is a chance that low to moderate income individuals that have overdue sewer bills may also quantify.

New Business:

Frederick C. Brenner III Subdivision. The engineer was unable to get the signed subdivision plans to the Township office. A motion was made by James Callahan and second by George Henry to table the approval until a later date. The motion passed unanimously.

Resolution for CDBG 2022 Application. A motion was made by James Callahan and second by George Henry to authorize the Chairman to sign the 2022 application for the CDBG funds. The motion passed unanimously.
