Roll Call of Officers

Minutes

A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to accept the meeting minutes of December 6, 2022, as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

- Reappoint Young Oakes & Brown. A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to reappoint Young Oakes & Brown to submit the 2022 Audit. The motion passed unanimously.
- Sewer Rate Increase.
District #1 Sewer.

A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to adopting Ordinance # 20230103-A known as the District #1 Sewer rate increase by 2% which would increase the minimum bill to \$107.47 per quarter. The motion passed unanimously.

Logan District

A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to adopting Ordinance # 20230103-B known as the Logan District Sewer rate increase by 2% which would increase the minimum bill to \$184.15 per quarter. The motion passed unanimously

Canoe Creek District

A motion was made by James Callahan and second by Kenneth Wertz to adopting Ordinance # 20230103-C known as the Canoe Creek District Sewer rate increase by 2% which would increase their sewer bills to \$122.40 per quarter. The motion passed unanimously

- Tax Certification Request.

A motion was made by James Callahan and seconded by Kenneth Wertz to adopt Ordinance # 20230103 to increase the amount that the Frankstown Township Tax Collector can charge for Real Estate Tax Certification Request, from \$10.00 to \$15.00. The motion passed unanimously.
