

The regular Township meeting was held on September 1, 2019, at 7:00 PM. It was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Roll Call of Officers

Supervisors Kenneth Wertz, James Grove and George Henry were present. Sec-Treasurer Beverly Henderson, and Solicitor Matthew Gieg, were present. Engineer Levine was absent.

#### Minutes

A motion was made by George Henry and second by James Grove to accept the meeting minutes of September 3, 2019, as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by James Grove and second by George Henry to accept the Treasurer's report as presented for the month of September. The motion passed unanimously.

Announcements – an Executive Session was held before the meeting on legal matters.

#### General Comment:

- Francis Hugg, Donald Clippinger, and Dwight Kennedy were present to present their case for Fair Districting. They are requesting a Resolution for Fair Districting, which will limit gerrymandering for the government. Mrs. Hugg feels that with the gerrymandering it will allow the current government to be re-elected. David Clabaugh questioned what percent of the Township have been split.
- Solicitor Gieg questioned how large this movement is and is it just in Pennsylvania.
- Dave Clabaugh questioned that if it is all about the people why can't they have the right to vote on this and if there was some polling in the Township. Most of the questions that were asked were not answered.
- Renee Calvert has requested a noise and lighting ordinance for which they are generated.
- Jean Walters was present and asked why we have Franchise with the Cable Company. It was reported that we get a percentage of the price charged to the people, and Atlantic Broadband has the monopoly on the cable.
- The question was raised of what happens when a resident can't make it to a meeting and has a question? It was reported that you put it in writing and submit it to the office and it will be placed on the agenda and discussed at the meeting. You can then check in the next month when the minutes are approved.
- We need an ordinance to keep farm animals on the property in which they belong.

#### Old Business

A motion was made by George Henry and second by James Grove to approve Resolution No. 10012019 known as the Authorizing Resolution for the 2019 CDBG Funds. The motion passed unanimously.
